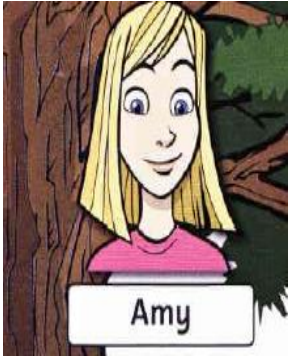

which

It is used to ask about people and things when there is a choice to make.

what

It is used to ask about people, animals and things.

whose

It is used to ask about who the possessor of something is.

when

We use it when we want to ask about time.

where

We use it when we want to ask about place.

why

We use it when we want to ask about reason.

how

We use it to ask about people, events and the way things are done.

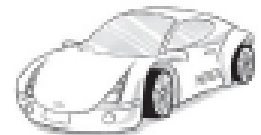
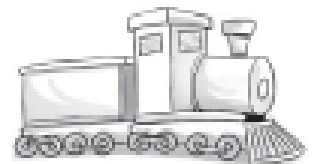
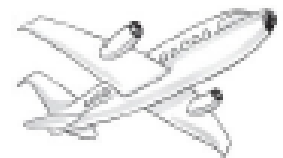
